PLAYER AND PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents or guardians of the soccer player, and the player will be required to agree to the Player's Code of Conduct as a condition of membership in Mississauga Croatia S.C.

- I the player understand that being allowed to play soccer with Mississauga Croatia S.C. is a privilege and that I am expected to follow this code of Conduct at all times.
- I agree to abide by the rules of the game applicable to the level of play in which my team will participate.
- I understand that I must set an example, and conduct myself respectfully and courteously towards everyone associated with the game and that my team, the organization, and I will be judged by my behavior.
- 4. I understand that irresponsible or disrespectful behavior towards my coach, players, referees or parents before, during or after a game or practice is inappropriate, and will not be tolerated nor will I publicly criticize or question my players or officials, but agree to raise any concerns privately in a civil and respectful manner.
- I understand that yelling, taunting, obscene gestures or language, racial or ethnic slurs, striking, attempting to strike or otherwise abusing an official, opposing player, spectator or coach will not be tolerated.
- I understand that I must abide by and respect the officials and their authority during games and will not question, or confront officials at the game field.
- I understand that I am expected to attend every practice and game to the best of my ability, and participate in all skill development sessions. It is my responsibility to notify my coach if I am unable to attend knowing that repeated absence may result in discipline to be determined by my coach.
- I understand that winning is not everything but having fun, improving skills, making friends and learning sportsmanship is the primary goal of the Club. I will win or lose with grace and dignity.
- I understand that any of the following behavior will be considered cause for dismissal from the club for the remainder of the current season following Discipline Committee review and approval:
 - a. Substance use and/or possession of drugs/drug paraphernalia;
 - b. Persistent irresponsibility or disrespectful behavior;
 - Destruction or Property; or
 - d. Violation of Provincial and Federal Laws
- 10. I understand that failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines will result in disciplinary action by the coach that could include, but is not limited to the following:
 - a. Verbal or written warning by the Team Official, Head Coach, Discipline Committee and/or Board:
 - b. Reduced playing time at the Coaches discretion;
 - Game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file with the Club;
 - Multiple game or remainder of season suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file with the Club.

If parents or legal guardian wishes to discuss with a coach relating to issues with their child, it is recommended they wait 24 hours prior to pursuing the issue. After such time, a private meeting should be arranged between the parent or legal guardian and the coach and his staff.

If a player and his/her parent(s) or legal guardian(s) feels that the issue (s) has not been resolved to their satisfaction they may send a written request to the Discipline Committee via the Contact Form on the Club website within 60 days of the incident. A serious offense or repeated violation may result in the removal of a player and/or parent from the club with Discipline Committee approval.
